## Indications for the oral presentation of the master thesis in the MBA degree program

- All rules are based on the applicable master examination regulations.
- After handing in the master thesis both assessors (in charge is the supervisor) make an appointment with the candidate for the presentation.
- Only the two examiners (assessors of the master thesis) and the candidate attend to the presentation.
- The presentation usually takes place in the Orangerie of Benrath Castle or at the Heinrich Heine University (rooms of the economic department, building 23.31). The specific location is decided by both examiners.
- The presentation should last for about 15-20 minutes.
- It is up to the candidate to do the presentation only orally as a lecture, or accompanied by a power point presentation, overhead sheets or a hardcopy handout. The examiners usually expect that the candidate hands out a paper copy of the presentation.
- The candidates are appealed to considerate the right scope and form of the presentation, especially the number of slides, in order to keep the time frame.
- The presentation is a resume of the master thesis. Contents may be: intention, approach, initial assumptions/hypothesis, collection and treatment of data (if appropriate), most important results, implications and managing consequences etc.
- There will be no examination questions from both examiners regarding the presentation. For questions concerning the grading look at the master examination regulations.
